History of the Left handed People

Using conjecture, bone structures, and prehistoric tools, scientists estimate that some sort of handedness began to show approximately 2-3 million years ago, [2] with a slow tipping towards the right hand approximately 2-1.5 million years ago (44% left handed compared to 56% right). [1] By 30,000 years ago, the percentage of sinistrals was down to 23%, [1] and dipped further until, in modern times, it has evened out at approximately 10%.
